


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Personal Schedules 2014-2015



Under Personal Schedules you will click on the RES G1 FP menu or the RES G2 FP menu, click on your name. Then go to CHOOSE MONTH & MAKE SCHEDULE – click on the 'month' your medicine rotation is on and click CREATE SCHEDULE. Your schedule with be produced and will look like:



Your schedule for the month will come up along w/your block dates highlighted above in yellow. If you need to move the schedule to look at more dates you can click on the arrows ← → and it will take you back one day or forward by one day.

Structure of Rotation

Resident will be scheduled for one week of night float during the block (the resident is excused from Wednesday Core Conference during night float week) with one ½ day clinic per week (with the exception of the night float week). The resident will attend core conference at WHC Wednesday mornings and return to responsibilities scheduled in the PM.
