Geriatric Medicine Description:

Geriatric curriculum consists of three components.

- 1) The G2 & G3 the longitudinal (24 month) PA-LTC rotation focuses on nursing home (Post-Acute & Long-term Care Medicine).
- 2) The 4-week Geriatric block rotation in the G2 year focuses on Palliative, Hospice, and Home Care.
- 3) The G3 longitudinal (12 month) Geriatric clinic rotation focuses on ambulatory geriatrics.

This provides ample opportunity to learn and gain valuable experience in taking care of older patients across a continuum of sites including ambulatory, short-term rehabilitation/skilled nursing facility (SNF), long-term care, home and hospital.

Additionally, residents take care of older adults during the entire residency in hospital, ICU, outpatient, and emergency department. Resident physicians work directly with specialists from diverse disciplines including Geriatrics, Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF), Palliative & Hospice care, Sleep specialists, Addiction Medicine, Wound, Psychology and Psychiatry.
